

# 2024 Curtis Wood Memorial Scholarship Application

Curtis Wood taught and served at Prairie View A&M University for many years as Professor, Director of Communications and in various other capacities. He also served as Board Member of San Bernard Electric Cooperative from 1977 to 1987. In his honor, we are delighted to be able to offer up to ten scholarships in his memory as the scholarship symbolizes his commitment to the youth of our community and to education.

#### **Eligibility:**

- Parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must be members of San Bernard Electric Cooperative.
- Must be a graduating senior at one of the High Schools in our service territory or an accredited home extended studies program. (Bellville, Columbus, Faith Academy, Hallettsville, Hempstead, Magnolia, Rice, Royal, Sacred Heart, Sealy, Waller, and Weimar High School)
- Applicant must show proof of enrollment to Prairie View A&M University
- The applicant must be in the top 50% of their graduating senior class.
- Applicant must be attending Prairie View A&M University in the fall of 2023

#### **Selection of Recipients and Disbursement of Funds:**

Ten scholarships will be awarded. Recipients of the scholarships will be chosen based on the following:

Financial necessity - 40 percent Written essay - 20 percent Participation in community/school activities - 40 percent

The total scholarship award will be \$2,500 and will be disbursed the first two semesters of college attendance and shall be established in the sum of \$1,250.00 per student per semester. Recipients must provide a copy of their enrollment to Prairie View A&M University. At that time, SBEC will pay \$1,250/semester in recipient's name directly to the financial aid department. Student must maintain a 2.0 GPA for spring payment.

#### 2023 Essay Format and Topic:

The essay will be evaluated based on the following: demonstrating an understanding of the subject matter, originality, composition, grammar and neatness. The essay should be typed, at least 500 words in length, 12-point font and double spaced. It should be written on the following topic:

Describe an accomplishment, event or realization and how it relates to your field of study and your future goals.

#### Deadline

A completed application must be received/postmarked by 5 p.m. on Monday, March 11, 2024 Scholarship recipients will be notified by mail. Completed application (including all necessary documentation) can be submitted by e-mail or mail.
